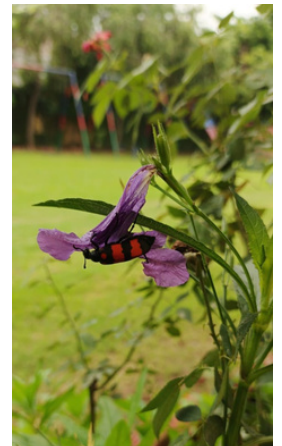


## Inter House Football Competition
